About the School

Association for Democratic Initiatives Sarajevo is calling NGO activists, diplomats and human rights practitioners from Bosnia and Herzegovina to apply for SUMMER TRAINING COURSE IN MALTA on Human Rights, Identities & Gender that will be held in Valletta, Malta in the period **10**th – **18**th June **2014**. Application Requirements

The application procedure consists of filling the application form (available on request) and taking part at an interview that will be conducted with successful candidates. Since the

language of the Summer School is English, applicants should demonstrate a strong command of English and strong motivation for the participation.

Scholarship

The Swiss scholarship will cover the course fee – accommodation in a 4 star hotel (sharing twin room), meals included, travel expenses, and travel insurance. Per diem will be given to the selected candidates, so that the evening meal (not included in the course fee) is covered, as well as meals during the travel. In the case additional nights in the hotel are necessary due to flight schedule, this cost will also be covered.

Accommodation

Accommodation and the training course will be held at The Victoria Hotel **** on a twin-sharing basis and includes breakfast and lunch. The hotel is located on a quiet street in the heart of the fashionable town of Sliema, walking distance from the seafront promenade and close to the most popular restaurants and nightspots of the Island. Participants who wish to have sole occupancy of room must pay a supplement of 20.00 Euro per night for the duration of the course. Extra nights and availability of both twin and single rooms cannot be guaranteed unless early registration is made.
